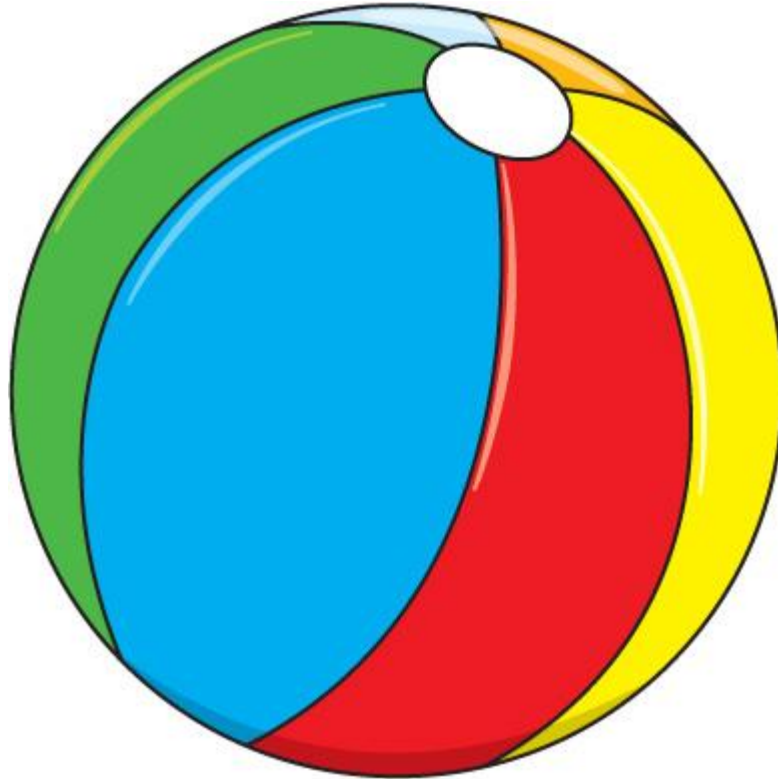

Conjugations is important for us to knowing because if we doesn't conjugate our verbs correctly in any language, we am going to sound uneducated. Conjugations is very important in any language, especially Spanish.

Let's look at the basics

1. What is a verb?

Choose the verb in each sentence:

The cat drinks water.

I am tall.

You eat the cereal.

Conjugations are when we have to CHANGE verbs in order to MATCH our SUBJECT of the sentence.

For example, we wouldn't say
"I are" or "We am"

Those are conjugations!

Today, we will learn the conjugation of a
VERY IMPORTANT verb in Spanish -
the verb “**ser**” or “**to be**”

We have actually already been using it and conjugating
it! (You just didn't know the word for it)



ser = to be



yo soy

I am

tú eres

You (informal) are

él/ella/usted es

He/she/you (formal) are/us

nosotros somos

We are

vosotros sois

You all (informal) are

ellos/ellas/ustedes son

They/you all are

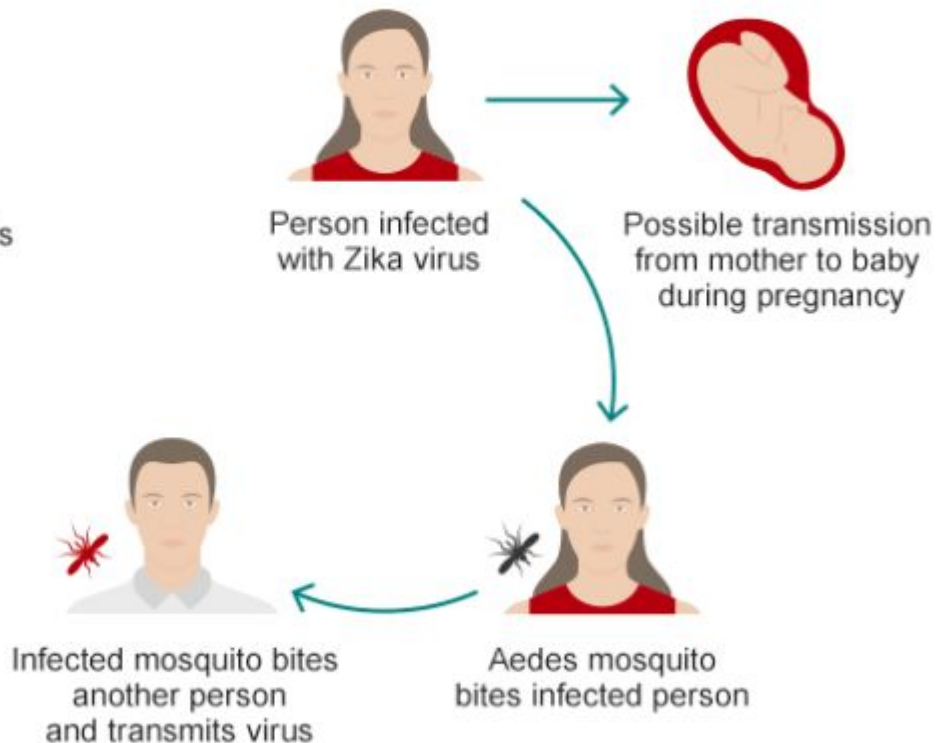
Un momento de la cultura - Zika virus

- Disease spread through mosquitos
- Many pregnant women are getting stung by the mosquitoes and then their babies have birth defects
 - Smaller heads and brain damage
- This is happening a lot in Latin America and has made its way into the US
- The World Health Organization declared this to be a global emergency
 - Some place it in the same category as Ebola
- Currently no vaccine or medicine for the virus

Zika virus transmission cycle

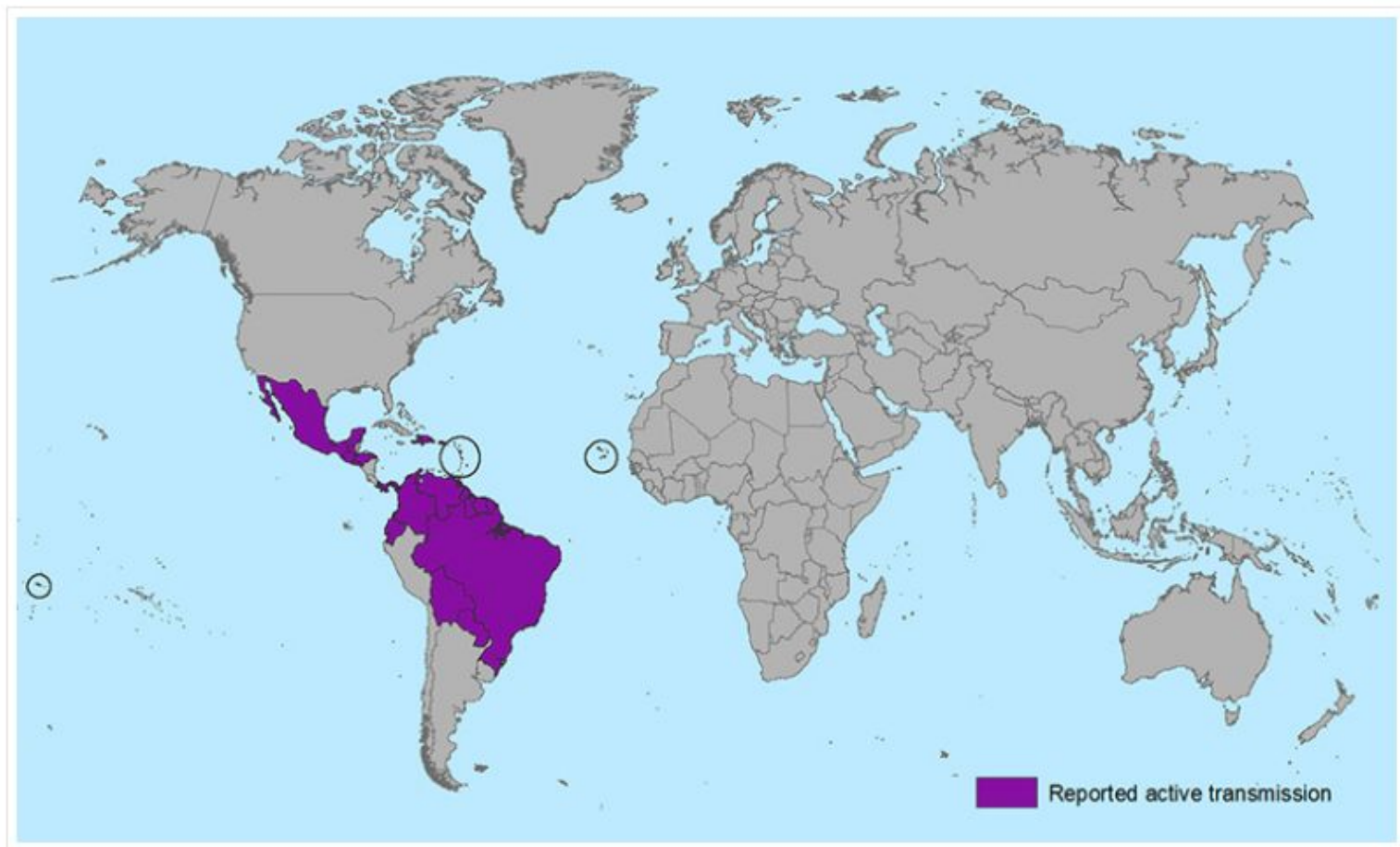
Symptoms

- Fever
- Rash
- Joint pain
- Conjunctivitis (red eyes)



Zika can be transmitted through blood, but this is an infrequent mechanism. The virus has also been isolated in semen, but person-to-person sexual transmission is unconfirmed.
