# Apartamentos vs. houses

## Spain

- apartamentos/pisos
- majority of Spaniards live in apartments
- large apartment complexes and communities in cities and large towns

## US:

- apartments mainly found in cities
- most people live in houses in neighborhoods

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# ¡Español es muy importante!

- Patients feel more comfortable receiving medical care if you can comprehend and speak their language
- Spanish is EVERYWHERE!
- It can help to know if you ever want to travel
- It's fun to learn!
- It can help you pick up other languages
- It can help in emergency situations

- El dolor→ Pain
- El síntoma→ symptoms
- Los ojos→ Eyes
- La fiebre→ Fever
- La gripe→ Flu
- La inyección→ Injection
- La garganta→ Throat
- Enfermo→ Sick
- “Qué te pasa?”→ “What’s the matter/what’s wrong?”
- “Me duele...”→ “I’m hurting (where)”
- “Tengo dolor de” ...”I have pain in my....”
- “Estar resfriado/a” ...”I have a cold”

# Healthcare/Life In Peru

- Lima, Peru
  - No clean running water
  - No electricity (very expensive to run up the mountains)
  - No sewage system/bathroom
  - On average, children only make it to a 3<sup>rd</sup> grade education level (they need to begin working)
  - Little money for food, medication, and clothes
  - 3-4 hour drive to nearest hospital
  - Fungal and parasite infections (unclean water, uncooked food)
  - Many children do not know how/don't have the tools to brush their teeth
  - Takes 10 years to own property
  - No staircases for elders, pregnant women, or children to use when walking down the mountains
  - Frequent robberies/crime because houses do not have locked doors
  - High rates of diabetes, heart conditions due to little access to healthy food
